WHAT YOUR FUNDRAISING MEANS



As a **charity**, we **rely on donations and fundraising** to deliver our lifechanging work, which costs £2,500 daily.

Our services are free, confidential and tailored to individual needs. From in-person or remote emotional support to criminal justice advocacy, our work is life changing. Our training, awareness raising and campaigning is also vital to help prevent and eliminate sexual violence.

FUNDING OUR WORK

Alex's Path to Justice and Healing



"Just knowing you have someone who believes in you and is with you through the process makes me feel like I'm strong enough to get through this."

After being sexually assaulted, Alex* contacted RASASH's Support Line and was connected with their Advocacy Service. Initially hesitant to involve the Police, Alex received reassurance from the Advocacy Worker, who emphasised that the decision was Alex's. Ultimately, Alex chose to report the assault and RASASH's Advocacy Worker facilitated communication with the Police and provided continuous support.

As the investigation progressed, it was discovered the perpetrator had assaulted another person. The Advocacy Worker helped Alex understand the legal complexities and accompanied Alex to a video identity parade, offering crucial emotional support. Ongoing guidance and emotional support sessions continue to help Alex through the legal process and towards healing.

Your fundraising efforts enable essential services like those that supported Alex. Your contributions empower survivors, providing both practical help and emotional support. Thank you for making a significant impact in their journey to recovery.

Essential Tips for Hosting a Successful Fundraising Event

OUR AGREEMENT



We follow the **Fundraising Code** and are registered with the Fundraising Regulator. This means we need to help you fundraise in a lawful way. To do this, we ask you to complete a fundraising agreement. We'll send you an electronic version to complete along with more helpful fundraising guidance once you've been in touch with us.

'In aid of' fundraising agreement

When you start to run your own fundraising activity in support of RASASH this is known as 'in aid of' fundraising activity.

All of your fundraising should make it clear that you are fundraising 'in aid for RASASH' but that you do not represent the charity, i.e. you are not an employee nor have you entered into a legally binding contract. Please make sure your fundraising materials like posters, leaflets and signs include the following line:

In aid of Rape and Sexual Abuse Service Highland (RASASH), registered Charity number SC045019. All proceeds will go to RASASH.'
